

# Make a Snowy Owl

The snowy owl lives in the Arctic, but sometimes pays a visit to northern Britain when the weather is very cold. Here's how to make your own fluffy, gold-eyed snowy owl.



## What you'll need:

- Paper cut outs - see next page
- A pinecone
- Cotton wool
- Glue
- String (optional)



## Step by Step

Tear up the cotton wool to make small fluffy pieces. Push the cotton wool in-between the scales of the pinecone, all over.



Cut out eyes and a beak and two wings from the next page. Stick them onto the pinecone (make sure the glue touches the scales of the pinecone, not just the cotton wool).



If you like, tie some string around the top of the pinecone and hang your owl on a Christmas tree!
